VIDEO REQUIREMENTS

The most important requirements include:

- Your camera is HORIZONTAL (a standard smart phone camera is perfectly suited to this)
- The camera is on a firm surface – please DO NOT hold the camera during your answers – the movement will be distracting.
- The camera is **AT LEAST level with your face**, or a little higher. If it's below you, we'll see straight up your nose LOL
- You are well lit, without too much light coming in from behind you. Natural light **in front of you** will look best.
- You are in a quiet room without background noise/distractions – we want to hear you clearly!
- Finally, please make sure we can see your whole face.
